



Dodge County (WI): No current ordinances found. (2022)

County Seat: Juneau WI

Cities

Beaver Dam (City): Crocodilians, venomous reptilia, reptilia over 10 feet prohibited.

Columbus (City): “Poisonous” snakes, snakes exceeding 3 feet, “dangerous” insects prohibited. Exemption for snakes exceeding 3 feet in public or parochial schools.

Fox Lake (City): All “poisonous” animals and reptiles including rear fanged snakes, crocodilians >30”, constrictor snakes, “poisonous” insects prohibited.

Hartford (City): Poisonous insects and arachnids, all venomous snakes, constrictor snakes, any snake exceeding 4 feet, crocodilians, monitor lizards prohibited.

Horicon (City): Ordinances not listed online. Inquire discreetly with your local clerk’s office and municipal hall. (2022)

Juneau (City): All “poisonous” animals and reptiles including rear fanged snakes, crocodilians, constrictor snakes, poisonous insects prohibited

Mayville (City): “Poisonous” or venomous insects or arachnids, “all venomous snakes, constrictor snakes, any snake exceeding 4 feet, monitor lizards, crocodilians prohibited

Watertown (City): All poisonous animals and reptiles, constrictor snakes 6 feet or more, and other species not ordinarily a household pet prohibited.

Waupun (City): Venomous snakes and other reptiles, non venomous snakes or snakes over 3 feet, crocodilians prohibited.

Villages

Brownsville (Village): All “poisonous” animals and reptiles including rear fanged snakes, crocodilians >30”, constrictor snakes,

“poisonous” insects, lizards/iguana type reptiles prohibited

Clyman (Village): All “poisonous” animals and reptiles including rear fanged snakes, crocodilians >30”, constrictor snakes, “poisonous” insects prohibited

Hustisford (Village): All “poisonous” animals and reptiles including rear fanged snakes, crocodilians >30”, constrictor snakes, “poisonous” insects prohibited

Iron Ridge (Village): All “poisonous” animals and reptiles including rear fanged snakes, crocodilians >30”, constrictor snakes 6 feet or greater, “poisonous” insects prohibited

Kekoskee (Village): Exotic pets prohibited in all zoning districts

Lomira (Village): It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to keep, maintain, harbor, breed or sell exotic or wild animals on a property or in any residence, household or dwelling unit within the village.(b)Definitions. As used in this article, the following term shall have the meaning indicated: Exotic or wild animal shall have the meaning of "wild animal" as provided in Wis. Stats. § 169.01, and shall include any dangerous, carnivorous, poisonous or venomous wild animal, insect, reptile, invertebrate or amphibian. Exceptions. The prohibitions of this section shall not apply to the following animals, provided that the conditions listed under subsection (d) of this section have been met:(1)No more than six nonvenomous snakes capable of growing to no more than five feet at maturity.(2)No more than six nonvenomous lizards capable of growing to no more than three feet at maturity, measured from snout to end of body. Fancier’s Permit Required

Randolph (Village): All “poisonous” animals and reptiles including rear fanged snakes, crocodilians, constrictor snakes, poisonous insects prohibited.

Reeseville (Village): Any venomous reptiles, dangerous or carnivorous animals, insects, or dangerous domestic animals prohibited.

Theresa (Village): All poisonous animals and reptiles, constrictor snakes 6 feet or more, and other species not ordinarily a household pet prohibited.
