



**Iowa County (WI): Permit application required for wild and exotic animals.**

#### *Cities*

**Dodgeville (City):** Incomplete list of ordinances on website. No current ordinances found from list online, but still inquire discreetly. (2022)

**Mineral Point (City):** No current ordinances found. (2022)

#### *Villages*

**Arena (Village):** All “poisonous” animals and reptiles including rear fanged snakes, crocodilians >30”, poisonous insects, constrictor snakes 6 feet or more prohibited.

**Avoca (Village):** Keeping animals other than dogs and cats restricted. (2022)

**Barneveld (Village):** No current ordinances found. (2022)

**Blanchardville (Village):** No wild animals, no snakes of any kind, no reptiles of any kind, and no exotic animals of any kind. No more than two nonpoisonous reptiles per household may be kept, for purposes of pets of the inhabitants, provided that such reptiles are less than 18 inches in length and will not exceed 18 inches in length throughout their expected life span.

**Cobb (Village):** All “poisonous” animals and reptiles including rear fanged snakes, crocodilians >30”, poisonous insects, constrictor snakes prohibited.

**Highland (Village):** No current ordinances found. (2022)

**Hollandale (Village):** All “poisonous” animals and reptiles including rear fanged snakes, crocodilians >30”, poisonous insects, constrictor snakes prohibited.

**Linden** (Village): No current ordinances found. (2022)

**Livingston** (Village): All poisonous animals and reptiles including rear fanged snakes, poisonous insects, Crocodilians 30 inches or greater, snakes over 10 feet prohibited.

**Montfort** (Village): Any poisonous or venomous animals prohibited.

**Muscoda** (Village): All “poisonous” animals and reptiles including rear fanged snakes, crocodilians >30”, constrictor snakes, poisonous insects prohibited.
