



Kenosha County (WI): No current ordinances found. (2022)

County Seat: Kenosha WI

Cities

Kenosha (City): Wild animals defined and prohibited as having dangerous propensities and not indigenous to the North American continent. Excludes small non poisonous reptiles.

Villages

Bristol (Village and Former Town): Crocodylians 30” or greater, Varanidae (only water monitors and crocodile monitors), any other dangerous, wild, or carnivorous animal or reptile prohibited without Permit.

Genoa City (Village): “Exotic Dangerous animals” prohibited. All Constrictor snakes, any Poisonous or Venomous animals.

Paddock Lake (Village): Any deadly, dangerous, or venomous reptile or other animal declared by public health to be dangerous, prohibited.

Pleasant Prairie (Village): Exotic snakes, “large” reptiles, other animals not commonly kept as household pets excluded as determined by Village Administrator.

Salem Lakes (Village): No current ordinances found. (2022)

Somers (Village): Venomous reptiles, federally endangered turtles and other reptiles prohibited.

Twin Lakes (Village): No current ordinances found. (2022)

Towns

Brighton (Town): No pertinent ordinances found. (2022)

Paris (Town): Exotic animals prohibited unless Town building inspector notified.

Randall (Town): No current ordinances found. (2022)

Somers (Town): Venomous reptiles, federally endangered turtles and other reptiles prohibited.

Wheatland (Town): No website found. Inquire discreetly with your local clerk's office and municipal hall. (2022)

Unincorporated and Census Designated Communities:
